An anonymous resident from **Highfield** got in touch with Katherine Barbour because she is concerned about landlords concreting over gardens. This nature loving lady told Katherine how she had been busy making the gardens welcoming for wildlife and nature, but sadly the landlords have been removing the planting and then concreting over the gardens. Katherine says, "Not only is this unsightly, it is also a risk with the

water run off into the road making a slip hazard and increasing the flood waters through the drainage system. These roads are looking sad, maybe the council needs to do some tree planting to enhance this area. There is no haven for insects, birds and wildlife. I have been speaking to students in the area to find out who their landlord is to ask if this can be put right. I will keep you posted on this."
